Decision to continue to restrict your contact with Victims Services

It has come to my attention that you have sent over 200 emails to Victims Services, copied into correspondence with other organisations from October/November 2023 to April 2024. These emails were unrelated to your claims with Victims Services.

On 9 November 2023, you were sent a letter advising that previous restrictions on your contact with Victims Services were reinstated. In this letter, you were also advised that contact with Victims Services was to occur based on your active claims.

The recent contact with Victims Services outlined above is unrelated to your Redress claim or other claims with Victims Services. Because of this, and your previous warning in February 2021 and November 2023, I consider it necessary to maintain restrictions on your future contact with Victims Services, including the Redress team. I therefore give you notice that effective immediately, and with the exceptions detailed below, Victims Services will only accept communication from you via email or letter that relate directly to claims with Victims Services.

What this means

You may only contact Victims Services using emails and letters which are directly related to your Redress claim or Victims Services claims. Any emails or letters that do not comply with this restriction will be read and filed without acknowledgement.

Review of this decision

This restriction will be reviewed after 6 months to determine if it should be maintained, amended or withdrawn.
